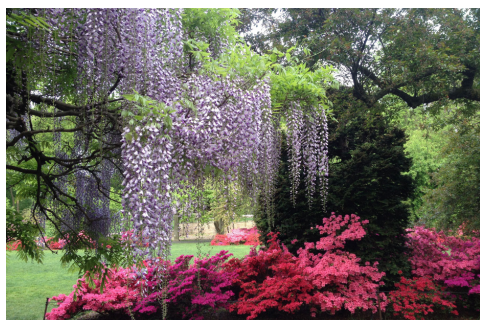


The Monkton Garden Club

A Bus Trip to
The Brooklyn Bridge Park and Brooklyn Botanic Garden
Wednesday, May 13, 2020

Please join us on a wonderful spring trip to New York City, where we will visit the Brooklyn Bridge Park and the Brooklyn Botanic Garden. We will depart from Timonium at 6:30 AM and travel to Brooklyn, New York. We will first visit the Brooklyn Bridge Park which is world-class waterfront park with rolling hills, riverfront promenades, lush gardens, and spectacular views of lower Manhattan. The Park is an 85-acre waterfront site stretching 1.3 miles along Brooklyn's East River edge. Upon arrival, we will tour one of the main piers, with the Park's horticulture staff, who will talk about the history of the Park and logistics of transforming the piers of the former Brooklyn shipping terminal into the vibrant waterfront park. After the tour we will have several hours to get lunch and explore the park on our own.

At 2:30 pm, we will board the bus to travel to the stunning 52-acre Brooklyn Botanic Garden located in Prospect Park, 3 miles away. At the Botanic Garden, we will have a docent tour and then time to explore the beautiful gardens on our own. We will leave the Brooklyn Botanic Garden at 6 pm to return to Maryland.

The bus will depart at 6:30 AM Wednesday, May 13th, from the Deerco Road Park & Ride (North End) in Timonium, MD. There will be a second pick up at 6:45 AM at the Park & Ride at Cromwell Bridge Road (Exit 29A off I-695), Towson, MD 21204.

The cost of this trip is \$125 per person (\$135 after March 1), which includes the bus charter, gratuities, breakfast snacks, guided tour in Brooklyn Bridge Park and docent tour in Brooklyn Botanic Garden, and light refreshments on the bus during return trip.

Deadline for registration and payment is March 10, 2020. No refunds after March 13, 2020. The tour will be conducted 'Rain or Shine', so wear appropriate clothing.
