Section A - "Plant to Create Indoor Color"

Eligible for Grower's Choice Award

Class 1 Container-Grown Flowering Plants - Container no larger than 7" across widest inside diameter. Plant must be in bloom. Cacti/Succulents excluded. Saucer required. Hanging plants not allowed.

Class 2 Container-Grown Foliage Plants - Container no larger than 7" across widest inside diameter. Plant may have insignificant blooms. Cacti/Succulents excluded. Saucer required. Hanging plants not allowed.

Class 3 Container-Grown Cacti/Succulents - Container no larger than 7" across widest inside diameter Saucer required. Hanging plants not allowed.
