Lunch:

We begin our Spring adventure with lunch at historical **Buckley's Tavern, Wilmington, DE**. Enjoy seated service which features casual American cuisine in an historic 1817 building that has been used as a residence, smithy, tollgate, and stagecoach station. Make your selection ahead of time from the following menu items when you send in your registration form:

- **Quiche Lorraine** - *Smoked Bacon, Onion, & Gruyere Quiche with French Fries or Coleslaw*
- **Chicken Caprese Sandwich** - *Chicken Breast, Tomato, Fresh Mozzarella, Basil Pesto, & Balsamic Reduction on Ciabatta, with French Fries or Coleslaw*
- **Crab Cobb Salad** - *Local Baby Greens, Jumbo & Lump Crab, Avocado, Hard-Boiled Egg, Red Onion, Cherry Tomatoes, & Bacon with Apple Cider Vinaigrette Buckley's*
- **Burger** - *House Sirloin Burger topped with Aged Cheddar, Smoked Bacon, Lettuce, Tomato, & Red Onion on a Brioche Bun, with French Fries or Coleslaw*

Following lunch:

We will take a short motor coach ride to **Jenkins Arboretum and Gardens Devon, PA.** where we have the afternoon to explore. Since 1976, Jenkins has stewarded 48-acres of woodland and gardens for the enjoyment of the community and the health of local wildlife and waterways. The original gifts of land were from the Jenkins and Browning families. Everything that is done at Jenkins is in partnership with nature. This unique approach to horticulture is becoming increasingly important as our world experiences dramatic changes in temperature, rainfall, and other climate-related events. They have worked hard to make Jenkins an approachable, accessible space for everyone who chooses to visit. On this trip, we will find azaleas, rhododendrons, and a variety of spring woodland blooms.
