Single species. Self-multiples, or multiple plants of the same cultivar and color, may be exhibited in the container (HB p. 58).

- Class 1 Container-Grown Flowering Plants inside measurement of container not to exceed 7" at its widest point. Plant must be in bloom. Cacti/Succulents excluded. Saucer required. Hanging plants not allowed.
- Class 2 Container-Grown Foliage Plants inside measurement of container not to exceed 7" at its widest point.

 Plant may have insignificant blooms. Cacti/Succulents excluded. Saucer required. Hanging plants not allowed.
- Class 3 Container-Grown Cacti and Succulents inside measurement of container not to exceed 7" at its widest. Hanging plants not allowed.
