Exception: Photography is not eligible for judging credit. b. Includes classes of Artistic Crafts and Exploration in Botanical Arts Division. B. Specialty Flower Shows 1. One class of either Horticulture or Design, according to the type of Specialty Flower Show. 2. Other five classes in any of the divisions: Horticulture, Design, Education, Youth, or Botanical Arts with the exception of Photography. (For a Specialty Show it is either Horticulture or Design).
